In a country where silence dominates public space, obtaining the facts becomes an act of courage.

In Turkmenistan, reliable and trustworthy information is scarce, and space for open dialogue is almost nonexistent. This vacuum breeds misinformation, fear, and distrust — leaving citizens with little voice in shaping decisions that affect their lives.



Corruption erodes public services, the rule of law, and trust. Turkmenistan ranks **165** of **180** countries on the Corruption Perception Index 2024 — among the world's most corrupt.

Independent journalism has been silenced. The country ranks 174 of 180 in the World Press Freedom Index 2025, as journalists face censorship and harassment.





Internet access remains severely limited. Only about 34.9% of Turkmenistan's population was online as of <u>January 2025</u> — among the lowest rates in the world.

Amid this information blackout, Progres Foundation emerged — to make data, information, and open dialogue accessible to all. Born out of frustration and hope, it brings together Turkmen nationals determined to imagine an alternative future for their country — one built on progress and collaboration, not fear and isolation.

Progres Foundation is an independent think tank dedicated to fostering critical thinking, informed decision-making, and civic participation in Turkmenistan. We work to promote progressive, inclusive, and evidence-based policy solutions for the country's future. We envision a Turkmenistan where people have access to high-quality information, think critically, act collectively, and shape policies that reflect their needs and rights.
